## CPR Certification Classes

CPR and AED certification classes are now available to the public through the City of Naperville.

According to the American Heart Association, CPR can double a victim's chance of survival.

Learning CPR can help make the difference between the life and death of a loved one.

### Become certified in CPR/First Aid and the use of an AED with trained Naperville Fire Department personnel

The City of Naperville recognizes the importance of Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR), First Aid and Automated External Defibrillators (AED). The instruction of non-Fire Department personnel increases both awareness and readiness within the community. This readiness plays a vital role in the chain of survival for heart attack victims.

The purpose of the City of Naperville CPR/AED certification program is to facilitate the education of the general public in the delivery of effective CPR and AED use, in accordance with current American Heart Association guidelines.

The Naperville Fire Department offers certification and recertification classes to laypersons and healthcare providers. The four-hour classes are \$45 per person for residents and Naperville businesses and \$55 for non-residents. Upon completion of the course, participants receive a certification card valid for two years.

All courses are taught by Naperville firefighters certified by the American Heart Association. Classes are held at the Naperville Training Center located inside the City of Naperville Electric Service Center, 1392 Aurora Ave.
