

Smoke Free Naperville

On January 1, 2008, the Smoke Free Illinois Act becomes effective. This law prohibits smoking in all indoor public buildings and most places of work.

Where will smoking be prohibited?

No smoking in restaurants and bars, within 15 feet of building entrances (including outdoor seating at dining establishments) and in all workplaces.

Where will smoking be allowed?

Smoking may still be permitted in tobacco shops and some hotel rooms.

What are the fines for smoking violations?

Fines for individuals in violation of the law will be \$100 to \$250, and \$250 for first-time business violations.
